

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs) on Admit Card & Conduct of Exam Related matters

FIT INDIA QUIZ 2022-Preliminary Round

Sr No	Questions	Responses
1	I am a candidate nominated for the Fit India Quiz 2022. How do I get my Admit Card?	A candidate can download, view and print his/her Admit Card from https://fitindia.nta.ac.in/c/admit/ using his/her Mobile Number provided in the application form and Date of birth. No Physical admit cards will be sent by post.
2	Can Schools download the Admit Cards of their candidates?	Yes. Schools can login to the site https://fitindia.nta.ac.in/i/admit/ using the application number and UDISE number and download the Admit cards of their candidates admitted to the test.
3	I represent the School. I have forgotten the application number. How do I get it?	On the log in screen of the portal, click the “Forgot application number” button and follow the procedure given there. You will get your application number.
4	Do I have to go to any exam centre to take the test? Or Where can I get the name and address of my Exam Centre?	No. You can take the test from your location. You need not go to any test centre.
5	How do I appear in the test? On which website should I take the test? Or What is the URL of the site from where I should take the test?	You are required to take the test on Android mobile phones. You will be required to download a mobile app for taking the test from https://ntaseb-fit.azurewebsites.net/ Details of the link from where you can download the app are also indicated on your Admit Card. You can download the app from the said site from 30.11.2022 onwards.
6	Can I appear in the test from a PC or laptop?	No
7	What are the specifications of the mobile phone that is to be used for taking the test?	Android Mobiles Only. (No IOS/i-phone devices) Android Version 10.0 and above.(Android has stopped support for version 9 and below) Internet Speed recommended 1Mbps and above (Broadband/Wi preferably). Keep 4G as secondary back-up. Mobile Speakers Working Mobile Front Camera. Webcam must have a minimum resolution of 640 x 480 @ 15 fps. 2 GB RAM or above Browser: Keep a version of Chrome installed in your mobile devices
8	What is the date and timing of the test	Test will be held in 4 sessions per day on 8 th and on 9 th December 2022. Timing of the test for each candidate is indicated on his/her Admit Card.

9	How do I know my test time?	Your test time is indicated in your Admit card. Please refer to your Admit Card.
10	I notice from the Admit Card/s that my exam date & time are different from that of my friend from the same school. Why is it so?	Exam time of candidates from the same school may vary depending on the language opted by the them or other technical considerations.
11	Can I change my session time?	No
12	How do I log in?	Log in ID is your Roll Number. Password is your date of birth furnished by you in your application form. Both are given on your Admit Card.
13	How early should I log in?	You are required to log in 30 minutes prior to the commencement of the exam. Your Log in time is indicated in your Admit Card.
14	In case I am delayed, can I join the exam after the commencement of the test?	No.
15	What is the duration of the exam?	30 minutes. Exact timings are indicated on the Admit Card.
16	How many questions are there in the Paper?	Paper comprises 60 Multiple Choice Questions. Each question carries 4 marks. Total marks are 240.
17	Is there negative marking?	Yes. 1 mark will be deducted for a wrong answer.
18	Can I leave the test if I complete it before time?	You can submit and leave the exam only after 30 minutes from commencement of the test, even if you complete the exam before that time. The SUBMIT button will get activated only 30 minutes after commencement of the exam.
19	I have not taken any test on mobile phone so far. Can I get some guidance?	A webinar is being organised on 28.11.2022 and on 01.12.2022, from 3.00 PM to 4.30 PM. for the guidance of candidates. You can attend any one of the sessions. The weblink where you can join the webinar is given in your Admit Card. Please go through your Admit Card. The link is also given hereinbelow, at the end.
20	Will there be any practice test?	Yes. A Mock Test is organized on 3,4 and 5 December 2022. The window will be open from 10.00 AM to 06.00 PM on those days. Candidates can appear in the mock test and get familiar with the process of online test so that on the day of actual exam they do not face any difficulty.
21	Is it compulsory to attend the Mock Test?	Yes.

22	Whether the site, log in ID and password are the same for both the Mock test and Actual Exam?	Yes.										
23	What will be the duration of the Mock Test?	It will be the same as the actual test, i.e 30 minutes.										
24	How early can I leave the Mock Test?	You can submit and leave the mock test only after 30 minutes from commencement of the test, even if you complete it before that time. The SUBMIT button will get activated only 30 minutes after commencement of the test.										
25	How many times can I take the mock test during the period from 3-5 th December 2022?	You can take the mock test only once during the specified period.										
26	Will be mock test be in the language opted by me?	Mock Test will be in Hindi, for those who opted for Hindi in their application form. For all others, it will be in English only.

29	Can I change the language opted by me?	No										
30	If I do not get my Admit Card, whom should I contact?	<p>You can check with your School. Your School can download/print your Admit Card and provide you.</p> <p>You can also call NTA Help Desk 011-6922 77000, 011-4075 9000 between 10:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M from Monday to Saturday or write to NTA at fitindia@nta.ac.in</p>										

31	Whom can I contact in case my admit card has some issue, or I am not able to download my admit card? 32	What documents should I keep with me during the test?	Candidates are permitted to keep the following with himself/herself during the test: a) Admit Card downloaded from the NTA website b) Any one of the original and valid Photo Identification Proof issued by the government – PAN card/Photo ID Card issued by the School/ Passport/Aadhaar Card (With photograph)/ E-Aadhaar/ Ration Card./ Aadhaar Enrolment No. with Photo or a Photo ID issued by the School or a letter giving details of the candidate with his/her photograph and signature duly attested by the Head Master. c) Drinking water in a transparent bottle <i>Note: Candidate are not allowed to keep personal items such as digital/analogue watches, food items, study material, lockets, bags, electronic gadgets or any other prohibited items</i>
33	Should I keep any paper to do rough work?	No. You are not permitted to keep any paper for doing any rough work, during the exam.
34	Can I move back and forth between the questions?	Yes, You can navigate between the questions by following the instructions available on the User Interface. You may change even answer options, anytime before you click the submit button.
35	What if I could not appear in the examination on scheduled date/session?	No candidate will be allowed to appear at the examination date/timings other than that allotted to him/her on his/her Admit card. For those who are unable to appear on the scheduled date/time of the exam for any reason, re-test shall not be held under any circumstances.
36	How do I know when the exam time has ended?	There will be an on-screen timer on the top right corner of your screen which will count down for the allocated time. You are advised to check this timer regularly and allocate your time carefully.
37	When will the result be declared?	Please be in touch with NTA website https://fitindia.nta.ac.in for the exact date when the result will be declared.

38	How will I come to know of my result?	List of qualified candidates will be hosted on the NTA website, i.e. https://fitindia.nta.ac.in Candidates can view the same.
39	What is the criteria for handling errors/ exceptions in the question paper?	<p>If more than one option is correct, those who have marked any of the correct options will be given full marks.</p> <p>If the question is wrong or none of the options is correct, the question would be dropped and the total number of questions/marks of the test would stand reduced accordingly.</p>
